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## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

This permit is also valid for Lawn, Yard, Attic, Porch, Room, Backyard, Tag, Patio, Flea Market and Rummage Sales. All sales must be for the purpose of disposing of personal property. Personal property is defined as property which is owned, utilized and maintained by a person and/or his or her household and acquired in the normal course of living in or maintaining a residence, which SHALL NOT INCLUDE MERCHANDISE PURCHASED FOR RESALE OR OBTAINED ON CONSIGNMENT.

### PENALTIES FOR OFFENSES

- A. Every article of personal property displayed, offered for sale, or sold in violation of Chapter 160 of the City Code, "Garage Sales", shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, each and every day a Garage Sales is conducted in violation of this Chapter shall constitute a separate offense.
- B. Any person, homeowners association, civic group conducting a Garage Sale in violation of Chapter 160 of the City Code, "Garage Sales", shall, upon conviction, be fined not more than \$250 for each and every offense of this Chapter.
